Below are the 2009/2010 ITBS scores.

Students in Grades 1-8 take this test and each student should have already received a printout and an explanation of their scores.

We have listed the average GRADES' equivalent, which tell you how the class (i.e., 2, 3, 4, 5) scored with all the students nationwide who took the test. The real value for you is to know about and understand your child's score and how s/he did when compared to the other students in his/her class. We have also included the Percentile Rank of the Average SS. This score compares our school against all schools who took the test nationwide. For example: 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, our composite score was better than 86% of the schools nationwide who took the ITBS.

EXAMPLE: 3.6 means Grade 3, 6<sup>th</sup> month, i.e., our Second Graders Language Score of 3.3 means they scored where average Third Graders would be after three months of school.
